RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO ACCEPT AND APPROPRIATE GRANT FUNDS IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$50,000.00) FROM THE PETCO FOUNDATION TO PROVIDE ACCESS TO VETERINARY SERVICES FOR PET GUARDIANS WITH LIMITED RESOURCES FOR A ONE-YEAR PERIOD.

WHEREAS. Oakland Animal Services (OAS) largely serves Oakland citizens who lack the financial resources to provide veterinary care for their pets; and

WHEREAS, the majority of animals OAS intakes come from East Oakland neighborhoods that lack access to veterinary services and other support for animals; and

WHEREAS. OAS currently provides grant-funded, community-based veterinary clinics for pet guardians who are experiencing homelessness and wishes to expand these services to other pet quardians with limited resources; and

WHEREAS, Petco Foundation has agreed to donate \$50,000 to allow OAS to provide free veterinary services to people who could not otherwise access them, at no expense to the City of Oakland: now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Administrator, or designee, is authorized to accept and appropriate donated funds from Petco Foundation in an amount not to exceed fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) to fund veterinary outreach clinics in East Oakland for a one-year period; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is authorized to complete all negotiations and complete all contracts, amendments, modifications and extensions consistent with this resolution and its basic purposes.
