(1) Production descriptions and specifications for Controlled Equipment and inventory numbers of each type of Controlled Equipment in the Police Department's possession. The Police Commission may waive the remaining obligations for annual reporting for a specific type of equipment if the Police Department certifies, in advance of issuing the Annual Controlled Equipment Report, that the equipment was neither used nor Purchased in the immediately preceding calendar year.

(c) The use of Controlled Equipment is unlikely to result in the disproportionate impacts to members of the public basal on their race, national origin, religion, sexual orientation, gender, gender identity, political viewpoint, or disability.
