RESOLUTION:

- 1. ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING A SECOND CHANCE ACT GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE OFFICE OF JUVENILE JUSTICE AND DELINQUENCY PREVENTION; AND
- 2. AWARDING A GRANT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED ONE HUNDRED TWENTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$125,000) TO EAST BAY ASIAN YOUTH CENTER INC. TO PILOT A JUVENILE GANG INTERVENTION PROGRAM FROM JULY 1, 2021 TO DECEMBER 30, 2022 USING THE SECOND CHANCE ACT GRANT FUNDS AWARDED TO THE CITY OF OAKLAND.

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 87756 C.M.S. authorized the City's acceptance and appropriation of an Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention (OJJDP) "Second Chance" Act grant in an estimated annual amount of \$100,000 from Alameda County Probation Department (ACPD) for the City to pilot a juvenile gang intervention program through October 31, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 87835 C.M.S. amended Resolution No. 87756 C.M.S to award East Bay Asian Youth Center (EBAYC) the OJJDP Second Chance Act Pilot grant for City FY 19/20; and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 88248 C.M.S. awarded a grant to EBAYC for City FY 20/21; and

WHEREAS, The City is expected to receive \$125,000 from OJJDP in City Fiscal Year (FY) 21/22 to pilot year three of the gang intervention program; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends awarding year three of the Second Chance Act grant to existing grantee, EBAYC, for the term of July 1, 2021 to December 30, 2022 for an amount not to exceed \$125,000; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council herby accepts and appropriates a Second Chance Act grant in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand dollars (\$125,000) from the United States Department of Justice Office of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Second Chance Act grant funds shall be appropriated to Project 1005116, Organization 70211, Expense 54911, Task 1 DEFAULT, Award 21614, Fund 2112. and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Council hereby awards a grant in an amount not to exceed One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand dollars (\$125,000) to East Bay Asian Youth Center Inc. to pilot the juvenile gang intervention program from July 1, 2021 – December 30, 2022; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the City Administrator is hereby authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, agreements, payment requests and related actions necessary to achieve the basic purpose of this resolution; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That said agreements shall be approved as to form and legality by the Office of the City Attorney and placed on file in the Office of the City Clerk.
