RESOLUTION WAIVING THE REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS/QUALIFICATIONS REQUIREMENTS, AND AWARDING A CONTRACT TO ATTHOWE TRANSPORTATION CO. DBA ATTHOWE FINE ART SERVICES FOR THE STORAGE OF SELECT AFRICAN AMERICAN MUSEUM LIBRARY MATERIALS FOR A FIVE YEAR TERM IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS

WHEREAS, this contract with Atthowe Transportation Co. DBA Atthowe Fine Art Services is necessary to continue storing the African American Museum & Library at Oakland (AAMLO) archival collections in a humidity controlled environment that meets professional and industry standards; and

WHEREAS, these collections are historically significant and unique documents chronicling the history of African Americans in Northern California and the Bay Area; and

WHEREAS, the Library Department and AAMLO seeks a continued storage contract for a five-year term with Atthowe Transportation Co. DBA Atthowe Fine Art Services to complete the processing and to continue storing these important historical documents; and

WHEREAS, to move these collections to another storage facility at this time is not in the best interest of the City, as it would disrupt the processing efforts and misspend human effort in moving collections; and

WHEREAS, Oakland Municipal Code (OMC) Section 2.04.051.A requires that the City Administrator conduct an RFP or RFQ process for the award of professional services contracts that exceed \$50,000.00; and

WHEREAS, OMC Section 2.04.051.B provides that the City Council may waive the RFP/Q requirements upon a finding that a waiver is in the best interests of the City; and

WHEREAS, staff recommends that it is in the best interests of the city to waive the RFP/Q process because initiating a contract with a new vendor would require moving the collections, which would result in a duplication of effort and a waste of financial resources and staff time already invested in this project; and

WHEREAS, the execution of this contract will continue cost effective and seamless storage of archival collections in a humidity controlled environment crucial and fundamental for preservation, at Atthowe Transportation Co. DBA Atthowe Fine Art Services an Oakland-based company; and

WHEREAS, the City Administrator has determined that services under this contract are of a professional, technical and temporary nature and that the performance of this contract shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive civil service; and

WHEREAS, funding for the proposed contract is available in the General-Purpose Fund (1010), African American Museum Library Org (61511), Project Number (1000013), African American Museum Library Program (NB18); now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: That the Council finds that pursuant to OMC section 2.04.051.A and 2.04.051.B, for the reasons stated above and in the City Administrator's report accompanying this resolution, that is in the best interest of the City to waive the RFP/Q requirements for the services to be purchased under the proposed contract and so waives the requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That the Council hereby awards a contract to Atthowe Transportation Co. DBA Atthowe Fine Art Services for the storage of select African American Museum Library materials for a five-year term in an amount not to exceed two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000); and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED: That based on the information provided by the City Administrator, the Council finds that this contract is of a professional and temporary nature and shall not result in the loss of employment or salary by any person having permanent status in the competitive civil service.
