This Ordinance would amend Oakland Municipal Code Chapter 9.64 to clarify existing definitions, add new defini-tions, and prohibit certain kinds of new surveillance technology. It also adopts California Environmental Quality Act exemption findings. Upon final adop-tion on second reading this ordinance will become effective immediately if it receives six or more affirmative votes; otherwise it shall become effective upon the seventh day after final adop-tion

This ordinance will amend Ordinance No. 13101 C.M.S., which amended Oakland's Local and Small Local Busi-Oakiands. Local and Small Local Busi-ness Enterprise (L/SLBE) program, to increase the use of Oakland L/ SLBEs in City contracting, with said amendments as follows and as more specifically set forth in Exhibit A to this without the set of the same set of the set ordinance:

 Revise the City's L/SLBE Trucking Program requirements by (a) requiring that to meet the 50% participation goal, contractors may only use trucking companies certified through the L/SLBE trucking program; and (b) removing the requirement that companies house or store trucks within the City's geographic region; and
 Create a business certification category referred to as a "Small Business Administration-Local Oakland Business Enterprise (SBA-LBE) category; and Reduce the size standard of an LBE where the 3-year average of gross receipts is less than o r equal to 20% of the most recently published United States Small Business Administration's Small Business Administration's Small Business Administration's Small Business Administrations to L/SLBE schedules after bid opening; and
 Applying a bid discount of 5% to a 50% subcontractor during construction bid evaluation, and a bid discount of 5% for professional services a 50% subcontractor goal; and'.
