Various departments are requesting new classifications to align with operational, and service delivery needs; this applies to the new Deputy Director of Workplace & Employment Standards, School Traffic Salety Supervisor, and Animal Care Services Supervisor, The pay rate of the existing non-sworn Police Property Supervisor classification is being adjusted to ensure alignment of similarly situated supervisory civilian classifications in the Oakland Police Department. The job title for Veterinary Technician is being adjusted to better reflect naming conventions and certification requirements in the industry; this titled change from Veterinary Technician to Registered Veterinary Technician to Registered Veterinary Technician applies to the full-time, permanent part-time and part-time classification equivalents.
