**SUBJECT:** Shelter Crisis Emergency Ordinance

Dear City Council Colleagues and Members of the Public,

The Council previously approved Ordinance No. 13456 C.M.S. declaring a shelter crisis on October 3, 2017, which expired on October 3, 2019. On October 1, 2019, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 13564, extending the previous declaration of a shelter crisis for another two years until October 1, 2021. The City continues to experience a severe shelter crisis, exacerbated by the COVID-19 Pandemic, in which thousands of residents are living unhoused or in substandard housing conditions. We therefore request your support for our emergency ordinance, declaring a shelter crisis in the City of Oakland, and making findings that a significant number of persons are without the ability to obtain shelter, and the situation has resulted in a threat to the health and safety of those persons.
