

WHEREAS, the City of Oakland has been a grantee of the Head Start Program since 1971 and is required to have an established policy council that shares responsibility with the governing body for overseeing the delivery of high quality services to children and families in accordance with Head Start Performance Standards; and

WHEREAS, Section 601 of the City Charter provides that members of City boards and commissions shall be appointed by the Mayor subject to confirmation by the affirmative vote of five members of the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 13230 C.M.S. establishing the creation of the Head Start Advisory Board (HSAB) to assist the Council in its role as the Head Start Governing Body by overseeing, monitoring and reporting on the implementation of the Oakland Head Start/Early Head Start programs; and

WHEREAS, the HSAB is comprised of nine members serving no more than four consecutive three-year terms; and,

WHEREAS, the Honorable Mayor Libby Schaaf has appointed Kevin Bremond to the HSAB subject to confirmation by the City Council; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**: That pursuant to City Charter section 601, the City Council hereby confirms the Mayor's appointment of **Kevin Bremond** to the Head Start Advisory Board for a three-year term that will begin March 12, 2021 and will end March 11, 2023 filling the seat previously held by Christian Batchelder; and
