Condition of Approval #53

Resolution 86963 C.M.S. (11/7/17) - approved Specific Conditions of Approval for Oak Knoll Project

Condition 53 requires:

- City will form Oak Knoll Project CFD and provide for two special taxes (subject to overall tax rate of 2% of appraised market value of residential unit)
 - perpetual Special Services Tax for public facilities maintenance costs (e.g., publicly-owned parks, publicly-owned bridges)
 - Facilities Special Tax to finance construction of the Oak Knoll Project's public facilities and certain capital fees, and pay debt service on CFD Bonds
- Developer pays CFD formation costs, subject to reimbursement from CFD bonds or Facilities Special Taxes
- CFD must be formed prior to approval of the first final map

Oak Knoll Public Infrastructure

Total Oak Knoll public infrastructure (including eligible City/EBMUD development impact fees): approx. \$132.6 million

- \$72.7 million funded by CFD
- \$59.9 million funded by Developer equity
- \$81.6 million for City-owned facilities (\$3.6 million for impact fees)
- \$51.0 million for EBMUD-owned facilities (\$22.1 million for impact fees)



Oak Knoll CFD - Facilities

CFD-authorized Facilities (transportation, water, sewer, drainage) and impact fees

Maximum Annual Facilities Special Tax Revenue: \$4.8 million (2021 dollars)

Bonds (\$150 million)



Oak Knoll CFD - Services

Authorized Services

- Operation, maintenance and lighting of parks, parkways, streets, emergency vehicle access easements, roads, bridges, trails and open space.
- Flood and storm protection services, including, but not limited to, the operation and maintenance of storm drainage systems (including landscape maintenance and replacement).

Services Special Tax

 Sufficient to pay \$685,000 (2021 dollars) of maintenance costs
