By March 2013 The Working Group Will Issue Recommendations On (a) General Policy, (b) Feasibility Analysis Bid/Request For Proposal (RFP) And Contract Language, (c) Insurance Program Design, (d) Safety And Loss Control, (e) Administration, (f) Claims Management And Adjudication, And (g) Funding Sources. City Administrator Shall Provide A Status Report At The First CED Committee Meeting In January 2013 To Include The Membership Roster And Schedule Of Meetings Of The OCIP Working Group 12-0213
