- 1) Equity measures shall be included in the implementation regulations;
- 2) Fifty (50) percent of all medical cannabis permits shall be issued to primary applicants who have lived, for at least one year, in a census track or police beat which has been heavily and negatively impacted by law enforcement with respect to cannabis; and
- 3) The primary applicant must maintain fifty-one (51) percent ownership of the operation.
