- 3) Page 2, Section C, part 1) after "low-income households" adding "those at 55% AMI and below";
- 4) Page 2, Section C, part 2) striking "other funds" and replacing with "Measure W and 2020 Measure Q Homelessness Funds";
- 5) Page 2, Section C, part 3) striking "before March 15th, and then may respond to the Mayor's proposed budget after May 1st but before June 1st"
