Recommendation: Adopt An Ordinance Amending Chapter 3.12 Of The Oakland Municipal Code (AKA "The City Of Oakland Campaign Reform Act ["OCRA"]) To Establish: 1) The Manner By Which A Candidate Who Declines To Accept Voluntary Expenditure Ceilings Or A Committee That Makes Independent Expenditures Shall Provide Notice To The City That Specified Contribution Or Expenditure Thresholds Have Been Equaled Or Exceeded; 2) The Manner By Which A Candidate Shall Seek Relief From His Or Her Voluntary Expenditure Ceiling Previously Accepted Pursuant To Section 3.12.190; And 3) The Authority Of The Oakland Public Ethics Commission To Subject To Enforcement Proceedings Any Person Or Committee That Fails To File Timely And Accurate Notice Of Equaling Or Exceeding Specified Contribution Or Expenditure Thresholds
