Recommendation: Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator To (1) Waive The Competitive Process And Enter Into An Agreement With The Alameda County Community Food Bank In An Amount Not To Exceed \$100,000 From The General Purpose Fund For The Procurement Of Bulk Foods And The Acceptance Of Donated Foods For The City Of Oakland Hunger Program For The Period Of September 1, 2010 Through June 30, 2011; And (2) Renew The Food Bank Agreement Annually Thereafter Without Returning To Council For As Long As City Appropriates Funds To Support The Hunger Program Through The Budget Process; And (3) Allocate To The Food Bank Agreement Any Additional Funds That Might Be Donated To The Hunger Program From Outside Sources Without Returning To Council; And (4) Grandfather In Current Procurement Practices For Spot Purchases Of Food Commodities Until Full Compliance With Requirements Of The Purchasing Ordinance Can Be Implemented
