That Established A General Fund Reserve Policy To Exempt These Distributions From The Requirement To Use One Time Revenues To Pay For One Time Expenses Or Reduce Negative Fund Balances, And (3) Appropriating And Transferring Such Distributions From The General Purpose Fund To The Affordable Housing Trust Fund
