Suspending Section 1, Part C Of The City Of Oakland Consolidated Fiscal Policy (Ordinance No. 13487 C.M.S.), Which Requires A Percentage Of The City's Excess Real Estate Transfer Tax To Be Allocated To The Vital Services Stabilization Fund And Used To Fund Debt Retirement And Unfunded Long-Term Obligations, For Fiscal Years 2018-19, 2019-20, And 2020-21; And 2. Authorizing The Use Of Vital Services Stabilization Reserve Funds For Fiscal Year 2020-21 Pursuant To Section 2, Part B Of The City Of Oakland Consolidated Fiscal Policy
