Subject: Real Property Transfer Tax - Ballot Measure

Recommendation: Adopt A Resolution Submitting To The Voters At the Next Special Election, Not Less Than 88 Days And Not More Than 150 Days From Passage Of This Resolution A Proposed Ordinance Amending The Real Property Transfer Tax, Chapter 4.20 Of The Oakland Municipal Code, To Clarify Application Of The Tax To Transfers Of Real Estate Resulting From Changes In The Ownership And Control Of Corporations And Other Legal Entities Without Increasing The Tax Rate; To Remove The Current Requirement Of Conformity To Statewide Rules; To Add A Definition Of "Person" To The Tax; Requesting The Services Of The Registrar Of Voters; And Directing The City Clerk To Take Any And All Actions Necessary Under Law To Prepare For And Conduct The Special Election (TITLE CHANGE)
