Title: Subject: Emergency Funding For Coliseum Connections Tenant Shelter

Recommendation: Adopt A Resolution: (1) Authorizing The City Administrator To Take All Steps Necessary To Apply For And Receive Reimbursement Of Expenses Under The Federal Emergency Management Agency's (FEMA) Public Assistance Under The Non-Congregate Shelter Program For The Major Disaster Declaration Of California Severe Storms Commencing On December 27, 2022; And (2) Appropriating Up To One Hundred Twenty-Five Thousand (\$125,000) To Constitute The Required Local Match For FEMA Reimbursement And Up To Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) For Reimbursement Claiming Expenses; And (3) Authorizing The City Administrator To Allocate And Appropriate Up To Two Million Dollars (\$2,000,000) To Provide Emergency Non-Congregate Shelter For Displaced Residents Of The Coliseum Connections Project; And (4) Authorizing The City Administrator To Enter Into An Agreement Of Not More Than Twenty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$25,000) With MGT To Provide Services Related To The Claiming Of FEMA Reimbursements; And (5) Authorizing The City Administrator To Enter Into Agreements To Secure Lodging For Displaced Tenants Of The Coliseum Connections Project For The Time Period Between February 13, 2023 And April 30, 2023 Without Returning To Council And Waiving The Competitive Process, Including The Local And Small Local Business Enterprise Program Requirements
