Subject: Opposition Of Proposed Voter Initiative That Would Limit Raising Taxes

Recommendation: Adopt A Resolution In Opposition To Proposed California Voter Initiative Constitutional
Amendment Ballot Proposition That Would Create Limits On The Authority Of Elected Governmental Bodies
And Voters To Raise Taxes And Certain Regulatory Fees By (1) Requiring Statewide Voter Approval For New
Taxes Created By Two-Thirds Of The State Legislature; (2) Limiting Voter Ability To Pass Voter-Initiated Local
Special Taxes By Raising Vote Threshold To Two-Thirds; (3) Eliminating Voters Ability To Advise On The
Same Ballot How To Spend Revenues From A Proposed Local General Tax; And (4) Creating A Voter Approval
Requirement For Certain Regulatory Fees
