Subject: OPD Cops Grant 2022 From: Oakland Police Department Recommendation: Adopt A Resolution Authorizing The City Administrator To: (1) Accept And Appropriate Grant Funds In An Amount Not To Exceed One Million Eight Hundred Seventy-Five Thousand Dollars (\$1,875,000) From The U.S. Department Of Justice, Office Of Community Oriented Policing Services (USDOJ/COPS) To Fund The Entry-Level Salary And Fringe Benefits Costs Of Fifteen (15) Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) Police Officers And Appropriate The Funds To The Oakland Police Department (OPD); (2) Authorize An Appropriation Of Thirteen Million Thirty Three Thousand Four Hundred And Nineteen Dollars (\$13,033,419) To Cover The Local Match Requirement; And (3) Authorize The General Purpose Fund To

Subsidize The Central Services Overhead Costs Of Nine Hundred Ninety-Two Thousand Seven Hundred Dollars (\$992,700) For A Total City Of Oakland Contribution Of Fourteen Million Twenty Six Thousand One Hundred And Nineteen Dollars (\$14,026,119) And A Total Program Cost Not To Exceed Fifteen Million Nine Hundred And One Thousand One Hundred And Nineteen Dollars \$15,901,119 [TITLE CHANGE]
