**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE PLANNING AND OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION TO:**

**AWARD OAKLAND FUND FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH (OFCY) GRANTS TO NON-PROFIT AND PUBLIC AGENCIES TO OPERATE DISTINCT YEAR-ROUND PROGRAMS IN AN ANNUAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED TWENTY MILLION SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY SEVEN THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED AND FIFTY SIX DOLLARS (\$20,677,356) FOR TWO FISCAL YEARS, FROM JULY 1, 2026, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2027, AND FROM JULY 1, 2027, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2028, CONTINGENT UPON FUNDING AVAILABILITY AND PROGRAM PERFORMANCE**

**WHEREAS**, the Kids First! Oakland Fund for Children and Youth (OFCY) was established by voter-approved ballot Measure K in 1996 to set money aside for programs and services benefiting children and youth; and

**WHEREAS**, OFCY was extended for 12 years by voter approval in 2009 (Measure D); and

**WHEREAS**, the Planning and Oversight Committee (POC) was established pursuant to Measure K to provide oversight and direction for the OFCY planning and funding review process; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to the authority provided in Charter section 1307, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 13588 C.M.S. on March 3, 2020, which extended OFCY for an additional twelve (12) years, beginning July 1, 2021, and continuing through June 30, 2033; and

**WHEREAS**, on December 17, 2024, the City Council approved the OFCY FY 2025-2028 Strategic Investment Plan (SIP) through [Resolution 90580 C.M.S.](#); and

**WHEREAS**, on October 24, 2026, OFCY released the Fiscal Years (FY) 2026 – 2028 Request for Proposals (RFP) for programs funded under the FY 2025 – 2028 SIP; and

**WHEREAS**, of the 300 year-round program proposals received, 136 programs are recommended for funding; and

**WHEREAS**, on May 6, 2026, the POC unanimously approved the funding recommendations; and

**WHEREAS**, the appropriation for FY 2026-2027 to the Kids First Oakland Fund for Children and Youth in the estimated amount of \$22,126,868.00 is included in the Mayor’s FY 2026-2027 Proposed Midcycle Budget (amount subject to change with the pending adoption of the FY 2026-27 Midcycle Budget), and 90% of the appropriation in the estimated amount of \$19,914,181.00 is available for grants and is located in Kids First Oakland Children’s Fund (1780), Youth Services Organization (78251), OFCY 2026-2027 Project (1007730), OFCY Program (YS04); and

**WHEREAS**, carry forward (CF) funding will be used in addition to the annual Oakland Kids First! Children’s Fund allocation, to cover the difference between the amount requested and the amount available in the Oakland Kids First! Children’s Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, the total estimated CF amount from FY 2013-2024 is \$16,616,778, of which an estimated \$7,011,973.20 will be used to cover the difference between the amount requested and the amount available in the Oakland Kids First! Children’s Fund; and

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Charter section 1300, any interest earned and amounts unspent or uncommitted by the fund at the end of any fiscal year are to be made available for future grants; and

**WHEREAS**, through this recommendation, over 23,000 youth and their families, particularly those with the least access to services, will get access to critical programming that promotes public safety, violence prevention, youth leadership, and academic enrichment; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council accepts the POC recommendation to award grant agreements to 92 non-profit and public agencies for 136 year-round programs for a total amount not to exceed \$20,677,356.00 for two year-round program service term grant cycles: July 1, 2026, through June 30, 2027, and July 1, 2027, through June 30, 2028, contingent upon funding availability and program performance; and be it
