EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

On May 17, 2005, the City Council adopted [Resolution No. 79235 C.M.S.](#), which created and defined the duties of the Community Policing Advisory Board (CPAB). Among those duties, the CPAB is required to submit annual reports and recommendations to the City Council regarding: 1) the City's community policing policy, and 2) block, neighborhood, and citywide approach to community policing. The report provides an update on the actions and activities of the CPAB to support the goal of strengthening community policing and improving community engagement in Oakland.

The CPAB annual report (**Attachment A**), CPAB Brochure (**Attachment B**), and CPAP workplan (**Attachment C**) was prepared by the Chair and Vice Chair of the Community Policing Advisory Board and approved by its members to be forwarded to the City Council and are attached hereto.


