NOTICE AND DIGEST

ORDINANCE AMENDING AND REENACTING OAKLAND MUNICIPAL CODE CHAPTER 3.08 TO:

- 1. REMOVE SECTION 3.08.240, BALLOT TITLE AND SUMMARY OF CITY MEASURE, TO CLARIFY AND REMOVE UNNECESSARY REQUIREMENTS FOR CITY-SPONSORED BALLOT MEASURES;**
- 2. AMEND SECTION 3.08.040 TO CLARIFY REQUIREMENTS REGARDING NOMINATION PETITIONS;**
- 3. AMEND SECTION 3.08.080 TO CLARIFY DECLARATION OF CANDIDACY FORMS; AND**
- 4. ADD SECTION 3.08.085 TO CLARIFY REQUIREMENTS FOR BALLOT DESIGNATIONS**

This Ordinance deletes Oakland Municipal Code ("OMC") section 3.08.240, which requires a ballot and title for City Council-originated ballot measures. OMC section 3.08.240 is duplicative of impartial legal analysis requirements already required for all ballot measures and is not necessary under state election law. This Ordinance would also amend language in section 3.08.040 to clarify requirements for nomination petitions and amend section 3.08.080 to clarify requirements for Declaration of Candidacy forms, consistent with uniform materials under state law. Finally, the Ordinance would add section 3.08.085 to clarify local requirements for ballot designations.

ORDINANCE 1) AUTHORIZING A FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 INCREASE IN THE RATE OF PROPERTY TAX IMPOSED BY VOTER-APPROVED MEASURES; AND 2) FIXING THE RATE OF THE PROPERTY TAX AND LEVYING A TAX ON REAL AND PERSONAL PROPERTY IN THE CITY OF OAKLAND FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27 FOR THE EMERGENCY MEDICAL SERVICES RETENTION ACT OF 1997 (MEASURE M), THE PARAMEDIC SERVICES ACT OF 1997 (MEASURE N), THE LIBRARY SERVICES RETENTION AND ENHANCEMENT ACT (MEASURE C), THE OAKLAND COMMUNITY VIOLENCE REDUCTION AND EMERGENCY RESPONSE ACT OF 2024 (MEASURE NN), THE 2018 OAKLAND PUBLIC LIBRARY PRESERVATION ACT (MEASURE D), THE 2020 OAKLAND PARKS AND RECREATION PRESERVATION, LITTER REDUCTION, AND HOMELESSNESS SUPPORT ACT (MEASURE Q), THE CHILDREN'S INITIATIVE OF 2018 (MEASURE AA), THE 2022 OAKLAND ZOO ANIMAL CARE, EDUCATION AND IMPROVEMENT ORDINANCE (MEASURE Y), AND THE WILDFIRE PREVENTION FINANCING ACT OF 2024 (MEASURE MM).

The proposed ordinance applies an increase of 2.2 percent to the current The Emergency Medical Services Retention Act Of 1997 (Measure M), The Paramedic Services Act Of 1997 (Measure N), and The Oakland Community Violence Reduction And Emergency Response Act Of 2024 (Measure NN) special parcel tax amounts, an increase of 6.4 percent to the current The 2018 Oakland Public Library Preservation Act (Measure D), The 2020 Oakland Parks And Recreation Preservation, Litter Reduction, And Homelessness Support Act (Measure Q), The Children's Initiative Of 2018 (Measure AA), and The 2022 Oakland Zoo Animal Care, Education And Improvement Ordinance (Measure Y) special parcel tax amounts, and a 5.0 percent capped increase to the current The Library Services Retention And Enhancement Act (Measure C) and The Wildfire Prevention Financing Act Of 2024 (Measure MM) effective July 1, 2026. The increase for Measures M, N, and NN is per the actual change in the San Francisco Bay Area CPI during the calendar year 2025, the increase for Measures D, Q, AA, and Y is based on the change in the California per Capital Personal Income, and the increase for Measures C and MM is per the change in the California per Capital Personal Income, not to exceed 5 percent for fiscal year 2026-27.
