**RESOLUTION 1) AWARDING GRANT AGREEMENTS TO CAMPS IN COMMON, CENTRO LEGAL DE LA RAZA, INC., CONSERVATION SOCIETY OF CALIFORNIA, EAST BAY ALLIANCE FOR A SUSTAINABLE ECONOMY (EBASE), EDEN I & R, INC., FAMILY BRIDGES, INC., FRIENDS OF PERALTA HACIENDA HISTORICAL PARK, OAKLAND CHILDREN'S FAIRYLAND, INC., SPANISH SPEAKING UNITY COUNCIL OF ALAMEDA COUNTY, INC., AND VIETNAMESE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT INCORPORATED OF THE EAST BAY IN A TOTAL AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,610,831.00 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-26 AND \$1,570,831.00 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2026-27; AND**

**2) AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINSTRATOR TO NEGOTIATE AND ENTER INTO GRANT AGREEMENTS WITH GRANTEEES FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025-2027 WITH AUTHORITY TO EXTEND THE TERMS WITHOUT INCREASING THE AMOUNT OF THE GRANT AWARDS**

**WHEREAS**, the City Council wishes to provide grant funding to the following entities identified in Table 1 in the specified amounts for Fiscal Years 2025-26 and 2026-27:

**WHEREAS**, the General Purpose Fund grant funding appropriation for these grants is separate from any other City of Oakland funding that the above-named entities may receive in Fiscal Years 2025-27, including funds allocated from other funding sources, through separate grant or contractual agreements, or through voter-approved measures; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to the entities in Table 1, the City also provides an annual grant to the Chabot Space & Science Center Foundation pursuant to Resolution No. 88460 C.M.S. and the API Cultural Center, Inc. to support the operations of the Oakland Asian Cultural Center pursuant to Resolution No. 89467, C.M.S.; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council awards grants to the 10 entities identified in Table 1 above in the amounts specified therein for Fiscal Years 2025-26 and 2026-27; and be it

**FURTHER RESOLVED:** That the City Administrator is authorized to modify, extend or amend the grant agreements without increasing the amount of the grant awards and to take any other action necessary and consistent with this Resolution and its basic purposes.
