### RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE OAKLAND FUND FOR CHILDREN AND YOUTH (OFCY) FINAL YEAR END INDEPENDENT ANNUAL EVALUATION REPORT FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024-2025

**WHEREAS**, the Kids First! Oakland Fund for Children and Youth (OFCY) was established by voter approved ballot Measure K in 1996 to set money aside for programs and services benefiting children and youth; and

**WHEREAS**, the Kids First! Legislation (Oakland City Charter Article XIII, Section 1305.4) requires the Planning and Oversight Committee (POC) of the Oakland Fund for Children and Youth to present the independent evaluation reports to the Oakland City Council for adoption annually; and

**WHEREAS**, the City contracted with the firm The Bridging Group (TBG) to conduct the independent annual evaluation for Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-2025 and report their findings; and

**WHEREAS**, for FY 2024-2025, OFCY awarded \$18,837,382 in grant funds and monitored 145 grant agreements with qualified organizations for direct services to children, youth, and their families; and

**WHEREAS**, TBG has presented the final evaluation to the POC, titled *Oakland Fund for Children and Youth, FY 2024-2025 Final Evaluation Report*, and submits the report to the City Council for adoption; now, therefore, be it

**RESOLVED:** That the City Council hereby accepts and adopts The Oakland Fund For Children And Youth (OFCY) Final Year End Independent Annual Evaluation Report For Fiscal Year 2024-2025 as completed by the independent evaluation firm The Bridging Group and submitted by the Oakland Fund for Children and Youth Planning and Oversight Committee, pursuant to Charter Section 1305.4.
